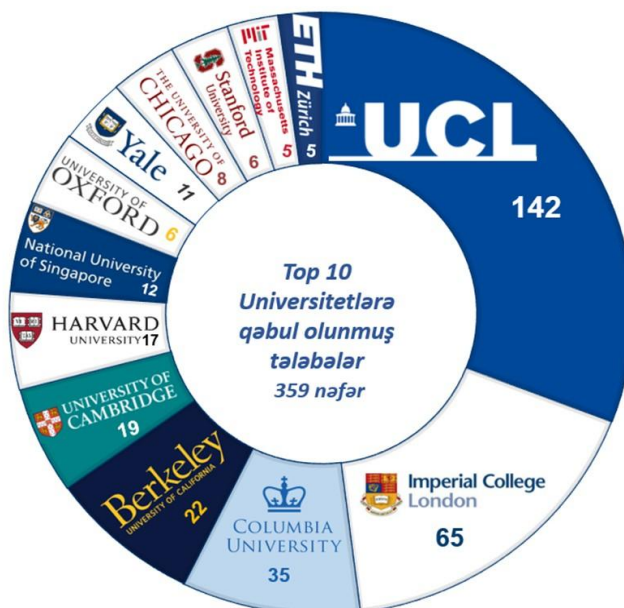


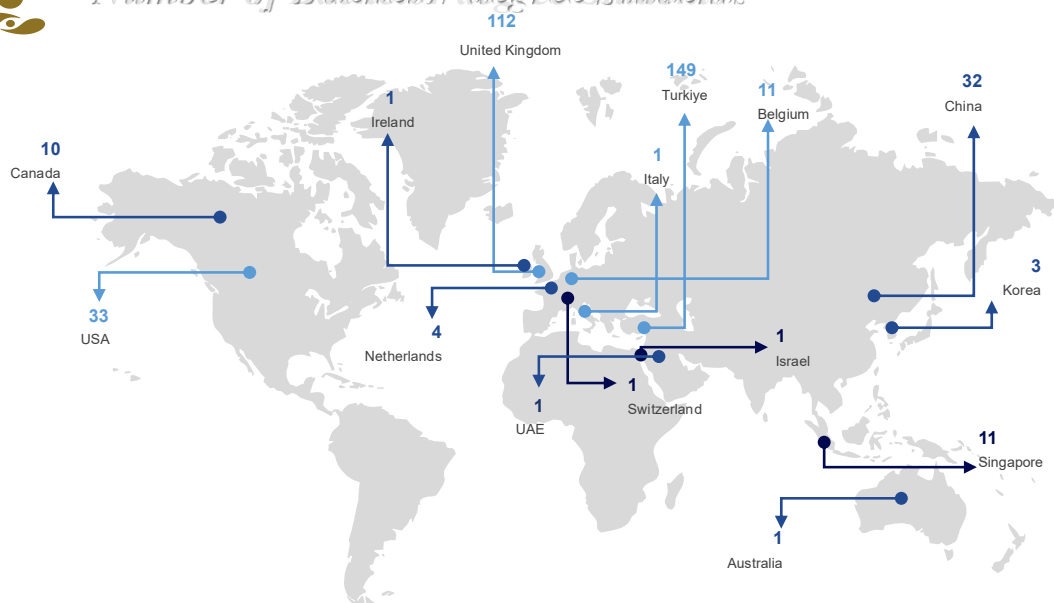
Information as of 30.06.2026 on the funds allocated to finance the education of students abroad at the Bachelor's, Master's, and PhD levels within the State Program for the education of young people at prestigious higher education institutions of foreign countries for 2022-2028 by countries, educational priorities, and cost directions

As of 30.06.2026, in total 1636 students' educational expenses were financed by the State Oil Fund of the Republic of Azerbaijan. 1247 of these students' study for a Master's degree, 371 for Bachelor's degree, and 18 for PhD. At the same time, 22% of the students, equivalent to 359 individuals, have gained the opportunity to study at the world's top 10 most prestigious higher education institutions.

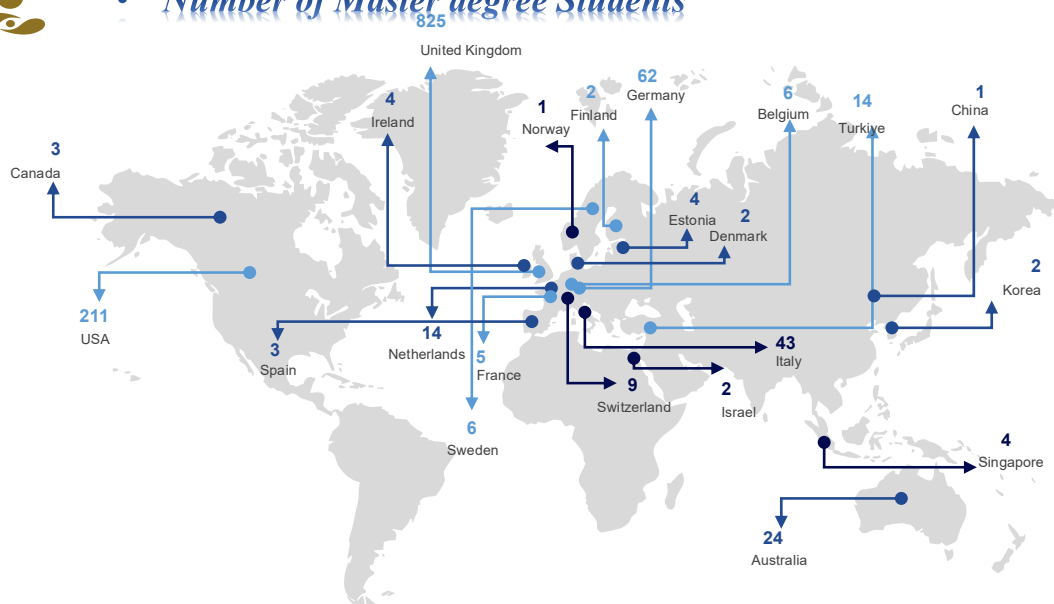




Number of Bachelor degree Students

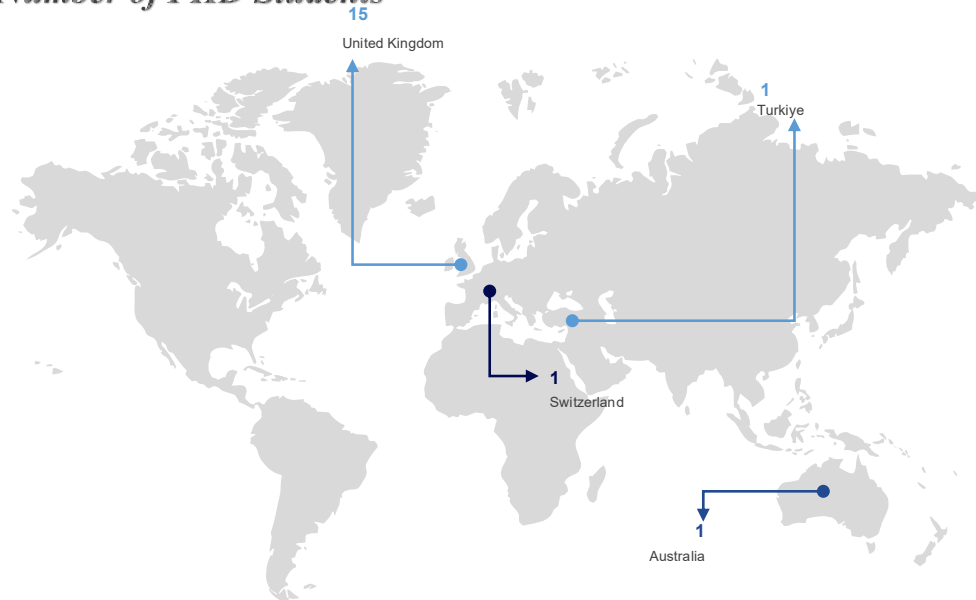


• Number of Master degree Students

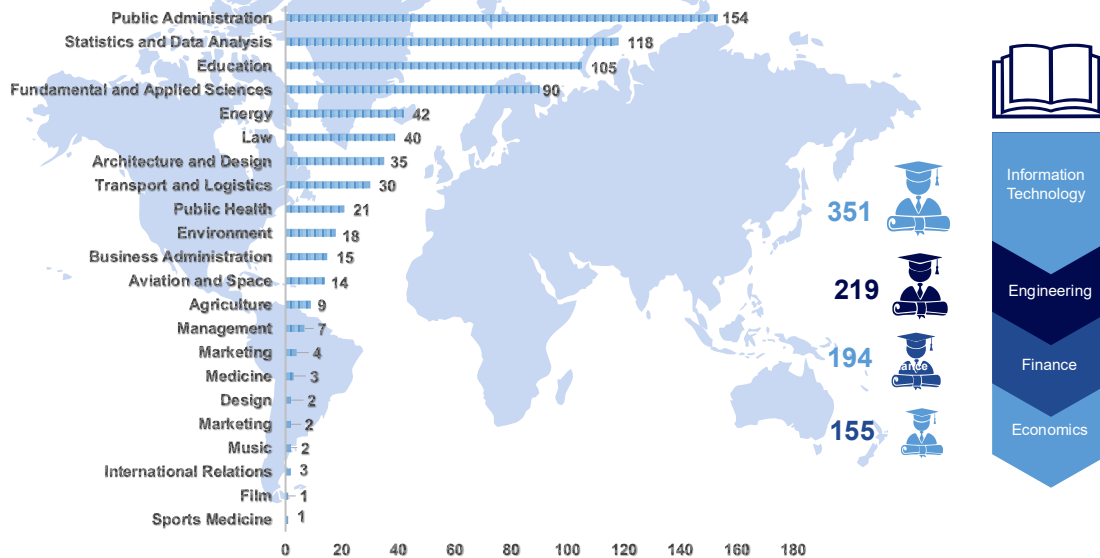




Number of PHD Students



State Program 2022-2028 number of Students across study fields



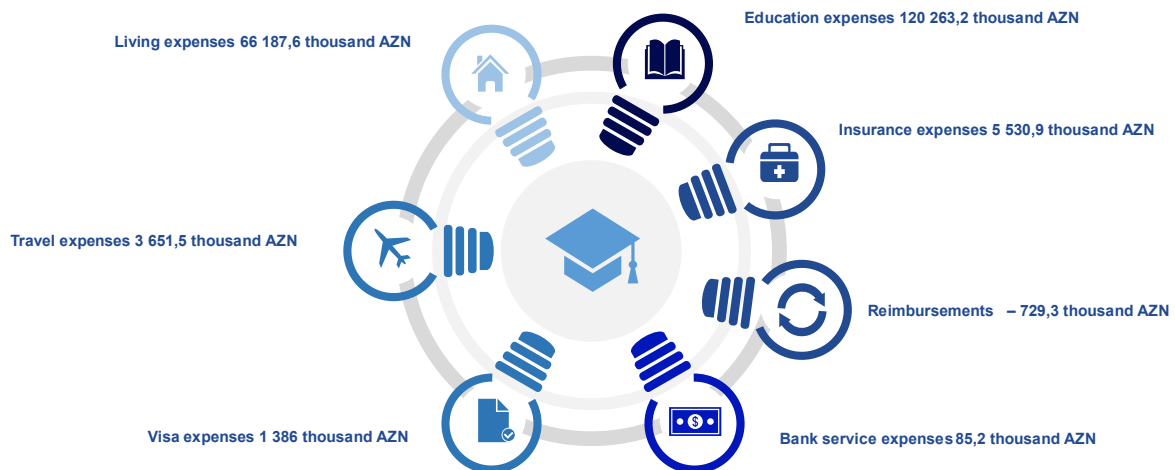
Number of Students by priority specialties

The majority of students at foreign universities study Information technologies (351 students), Engineering (219 students), Finance (194 students), and Economics and

Management (155 students). Students comprise 56.2% of the total program participants in these four priority specializations.
