

## Information as of 31.12.2024 on the funds allocated to finance the education of students abroad at the Bachelor's and Master's levels within the State Program for the education of young people at prestigious higher education institutions of foreign countries for 2022-2028 by countries, educational priorities, and cost directions

As of 31.12.2024, in total 1138 students' educational expenses were financed by the State Oil Fund of the Republic of Azerbaijan. 889 of these students' study for a Master's degree and 249 for Bachelor's degree. At the same time, 17% of the students, equivalent to 197 individuals, have gained the opportunity to study at the world's top 10 most prestigious higher education institutions.




#### 197 students enrolled in the world's top 10 universities


# Number of Bachelor degree Students



## Number of Master degree Students




#### Number of Students by priority specialties




### Distribution of allocated funds
