



Information as of 31.03.2025 on the funds allocated to finance the education of students abroad at the Bachelor's and Master's levels within the State Program for the education of young people at prestigious higher education institutions of foreign countries for 2022-2028 by countries, educational priorities, and cost directions

As of 31.03.2025, in total 1146 students' educational expenses were financed by the State Oil Fund of the Republic of Azerbaijan. 895 of these students' study for a Master's degree and 251 for Bachelor's degree. At the same time, 17.2 % of the students, equivalent to 197 individuals, have gained the opportunity to study at the world's top 10 most prestigious higher education institutions.


197 students enrolled in the world's top 10 universities




Number of Bachelor degree Students



Number of Master degree Students




Number of Students by priority specialties



The majority of students at foreign universities study Information technologies (221 students), Engineering (161 students), Finance (147 students), and Economics and Management (126 students). Students comprise 57,2 % of the total program participants in these four priority specializations.
